



# St. Dominic School Uniforms

## 2011-2012

All K-5 students are required to wear uniforms every school day.

### UNIFORM ITEMS

Uniform items may be purchased at any store. Look for bright red rather than maroon or brick red when purchasing solid red items.

The main components of the uniform are:

- Solid red, white, or navy polo shirt (short or long sleeve) with the St. Dominic School logo
- A solid red, white, or navy long-sleeve shirt may be worn under short sleeve polo shirts.
- Navy or khaki uniform pants, shorts, or skorts (chinos)
- Solid color socks or tights
- Closed-toe shoes (no characters, no lights)
- Any sweaters or sweatshirts that will be worn in the building during the school day must be solid red, white, or navy (St. Dominic School logo recommended). *There are no restrictions on outerwear that will only be worn outside (to/from school and recess).*
