Note from the Principal

IOWA and CogAT testing will begin tomorrow. Testing is only in the morning and will begin by 8:15 a.m. each day. Testing cannot be interrupted. If your child is late for school, he or she will have to wait in the lobby until his/her class has completed the section of the test they are taking at that time. When that section has been completed, your child will be taken to the classroom. Please make every effort to have your children to school on time. Thank you for your cooperation.

During testing, the four most important things your child will need for optimal brain power are sleep, healthy foods, water, and exercise. Nutritionists recommend oatmeal for breakfast because it keeps the body and brain powered all morning long.

The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) has endorsed the following guidelines of the American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM) to promote optimal health for children. In our school population, they are as follows:

3 to 5 years of age – 10 to 13 hours per 24 hours (including naps) on a regular basis
6 to 12 years of age – 9 to 12 hours per 24 hours on a regular basis
